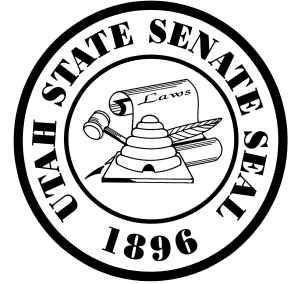

Performance Note Report

Serving a New or Larger Population

Public Benefit:

Purpose: The purpose of the new program is to enable public employees not currently with PEHP to save money by purchasing insulin at PEHP's fully discounted and post-rebate price.

Services: PEHP will provide a discount card to eligible public employees for use at an in-network pharmacy to obtain insulin at PEHP's discounted price, including claim-level rebates at the point of sale. These rebates would be paid by PEHP prior to PEHP receiving the rebate from the manufacturer. These public employees would be required to pay the full amount of the discounted price, but could thereafter seek reimbursement from their health plan.

Expected Outcome: The expected outcome of this program is that public employees will be able to obtain insulin for a lesser amount than they do now.

Implementations and Resources: This bill will be implemented by PEHP using its existing discount and agreements with a pharmacy benefit manager.

How: The proposed activities will cause PEHP to do some minor implementation of this program that can be handled within existing budgets.
