Purpose: This performance note only reflects on the assumed impact on local health departments to create a new food permit related to agri-tourism. This bill has a fiscal impact on local health departments. It requires each local health department to develop a program for permitting kitchens and requires that LHD's develop standards and regulations for participants to follow, with all the exceptions listed starting on line 141. Each LHD after developing the program would have to pass the regulation through their individual Board of Health.

Services: Development and implementation of a new permit.

Implementations and Resources: The details of implementation are unknown. At a minimum local health departments are required to develop a new food permit and inspections of agritourism events.
