Public Benefit:

Purpose: Within appropriation, the state board shall, in conjunction with the division, develop or select a student mental health screening tool that is age-appropriate and administered and completed online, unless requested otherwise by a parent or student. The tool will screen for mental health conditions and identify whether a student has a mental health condition that requires intervention. The screening tool requires prior written consent from a student's parent. The division shall collect and store data from the screening tool in a database, excluding a student's name, and organize the data by school district, school, gender, age, grade and student ID. The division is to analyze data and provide a list to LEA of results of the screening and any student whose screening indicates a need for intervention. The division is to also report to the State Board and State Suicide Prevention Coalition. LEA is to notify parents and work with them to provide treatment/interventions where needed.

Services: Screenings of school-aged children for mental health conditions where parents opt-in. Providing information to schools and parents of students in need of some kind of intervention.

Expected Outcome: It is expected that more children with a need for mental health services will be identified earlier and referred for necessary services.

Implementations and Resources: Within appropriation, the state board shall, in conjunction with the division, develop or select a student mental health screening tool that is age-appropriate and administered and completed online, unless requested otherwise by a parent or student. The tool will screen for mental health conditions and identify whether a student has a mental health condition that requires intervention. The screening tool requires prior written consent from a student's parent. The division shall collect and store data from the screening tool in a database, excluding a student's name, and organize the data by school district, school, gender, age, grade and student ID. The division is to analyze data and provide a list to LEA of results of the screening and any student whose screening indicates a need for intervention. The division is to also report to the State Board and State Suicide Prevention Coalition. LEA is to notify parents and work with them to provide treatment/interventions where needed.

How: By providing a screening, more children will be identified earlier and treatment/interventions provided where needed.

Goal

Title: Number of children screened for mental health needs.

Description: School-aged children will be screened for mental health needs when schools and parents opt-in to use the tool. This will be a new data point in FY21.

Collection Method: The Division will collect each of the screenings via Qualtrics which will provide an accurate count of the number of youth who are screened for mental health needs.
