Enactment of this legislation could cost the Division of Water Resources (DWRe) \$2,200 one-time from the General Fund in FY 2020 to prepare an updated cost estimate from the 2002 Green River Pipeline Cost Analysis; the Division has indicated they can absorb this cost. Additionally, this legislation could cost DWRe \$200,000 one-time in FY 2021 from the Water Resources Conservation and Development Fund to contract a study examining alternative methods of diverting the Green River to the Wasatch Front. This bill appropriates that \$200,000.
