Enactment of this bill could result in ongoing General Fund revenue, beginning in FY 2021 of \$67,100 from the assessment of fines. Revenue in the amount of \$424,000 would also accrue to the Criminal Surcharge Account beginning in FY 2021.

Enactment of this bill could cost the Judiciary \$41,300 ongoing beginning in FY 2021 from the General Fund for increased case processing impacts.

Enactment of this bill could result in a fiscal impact for local entities which could see fine revenue increase by an estimated \$291,100. This bill could also cost justice courts an unknown amount in court processing costs.

Individuals who violate the provisions of this bill could pay an aggregated \$358,300 in fines, and an additional \$424,000 to the Criminal Surcharge Account. .
