Enactment of this legislation could cost the State Department of Health \$3,700 one-time from the General Fund in FY 2020, \$7,600 one-time from the General Fund in FY 2021 and \$2,500 ongoing from the General Fund in FY 2021. These costs are all related to personnel for developing, distributing and supporting the training required by the legislation. The ongoing impact is due to annual modification of the training.
