Public Benefit:

Purpose: This bill creates a program that allows grants to agricultural entities affected by COVID-19 and interruptions in the food supply chain.

Services: Assist entities financially harmed by COVID-19 and interruptions in the food supply chain.

Expected Outcome: The expected outcome will be the number of entities receiving grant funding and continuing business operations.

Implementations and Resources: The bill will be implemented through written policy. Grant applications will be received, reviewed, and scored. Based on the scoring, grant awards will be made. Amounts will be between \$1,000 and \$40,000, based on need as determined through the grant application process.

How: The proposed activities will allow agricultural entities to who are suffering losses due to COVID-19 and interruptions in the supply chain to receive grant funding to continue operations. The department will measure the number of applications, the number of grants awarded, and the total amount of funding awarded for reporting to the Legislature.
