New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: Leverage lending resources through a loan guarantee program to finance Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) that will be rented to low-income individuals

Services: There is no funding increase stated. This would require an allocation within existing budgets for a new program. The allocation would support loan guarantees for ADU production.

Expected Outcome: Production of Accessory Dwelling Units. A guarantee of a 1:10 ratio would likely produce one unit at a cost of \$10,000 per unit.

Implementations and Resources: Would require the Olene Walker Housing Loan Fund Board to allocate dollars from existing resources to support a loan guarantee program.

How: The proposed activities will likely increase the production of ADUs with an allocation and decrease funds available for other production/preservation activities currently supported with the existing budget.
