Enactment of this bill increases the number of Weighted Pupil Units (WPUs) for the Special Education Add-on program in the Minimum School Program by 686 WPUs over the 88,328 WPUs previously estimated for FY 2022. At the estimated FY 2022 WPU Value of \$3,809 this increase in the number of WPUs may cost the State Board of Education \$2,613,000 ongoing from the Uniform School Fund beginning in FY 2022.
