New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: Members receiving coverage under the Children's Health Insurance Program will be able to access treatment services for autism spectrum disorder.

Services: Autism spectrum disorder treatment services.

Expected Outcome: Children enrolled in the Children's Health Insurance Program with autism spectrum disorder will be able to access treatment.

Implementations and Resources: The Children's Health Insurance Program is a managed care program, rates paid to the managed care plans that operate in CHIP will be increased to account for the new services, and the contracts with those plans will be amended to include treatment for autism spectrum disorder as a covered service.

How: By amending the contracts and rates for the CHIP managed care plans, the plans would be required and able to cover the new services under the managed care model.

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Goal

Title: Access to Services

Description: The rate of children with a diagnosis history of autism spectrum disorder accessing this new service will increase to the rate experienced under the Medicaid EPSDT benefit, which is currently 11.8%.

Collection Method: Data analysts will pull the information from Medicaid's data warehouse for program managers to review.
