Public Benefit:

Purpose: The purpose and duties of this new program are to promote digital access and digital literacy through libraries, community partners, and organizations; to provide statewide leadership and coordination related to digital opportunity and access, particularly to those most impacted by the digital divide; and to promote the development of broadband internet, in collaboration with the Governor's Office of Economic Development.

Services: The services provided by the funding increases are to support a full-time director of the Digital Equity Program, who will coordinate digital inclusion initiatives, provide digital education to libraries and community partners, and manage lending device programs for libraries.

Expected Outcome: The expected outcome of the new program is increased digital literacy and access statewide, particularly with those communities that have been most impacted by the digital divide.

Implementations and Resources: The bill will be implemented by the Utah State Library Division.

How: The proposed activities will cause a strategic alignment between the Governor's Office of Economic Development's broadband access program and the Utah State Library Division to address digital access and literacy through targeted research, education, support, and management of resources.
