Purpose: The purpose of the program is to provide family planning services to adults who do not qualify for any Medicaid coverage for these services.

Services: Family planning services.

Expected Outcome: The expected outcome of the program will be to reduce the number of unintended pregnancies in Utah.

Implementations and Resources: To implement the bill the department will be required to submit a waiver or state plan amendment. The department will have to set rules and policies to determine who would be eligible for the program, use those rules to determine client eligibility and program the department's claims processing system in order to process provider claims.

How: Currently, the population served by this bill does not have coverage for family planning services. The department's activities in implementing the bill will help these families receive these services.
