Enactment of this legislation could result in reduced revenue to the Division of Motor Vehicles Registration Restricted Account of \$250,000 ongoing beginning in FY 2023 from ceasing sales of certain impounded vehicles and associated fees collected by the division. Enactment of this legislation could also result in reduced revenue to the General Fund of \$702,000 ongoing beginning in FY 2023 from amounts left in the suspense account after funds have been paid out to owners.

**Regulatory Impact**

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Enactment of this legislation could result in a small increase in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.

This bill does not create a new program or significantly expand an existing program.

**Notes on Notes**

Fiscal notes estimate the direct costs or revenues of enacting a bill. The Legislature uses them to balance the budget. They do not measure a bill's benefits or non-fiscal impacts like opportunity costs, wait times, or inconvenience. A fiscal note is not an appropriation. The Legislature decides appropriations separately.
