# Local Government

Enactment of this legislation could increase revenues in Cache, Davis, Salt Lake, Utah, and Weber counties by a total of \$120,000 one-time in FY 2024 and \$721,000 ongoing beginning in in FY 2025 from charging a \$50 local emissions fee.

Enactment of this legislation could cost certain vehicle owners in Cache, Davis, Salt Lake, Utah, and Weber counties by a total of \$120,000 one-time in FY 2024 and \$721,000 ongoing beginning in in FY 2025 from paying a \$50 local emissions fee.

Enactment of this legislation could result in a small increase in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.
