### Local Government

Enactment of this legislation could require a noncontiguous community council area that successfully incorporates pay the costs of incorporation. To the extent that an objection requires modifications to a feasibility study report, enactment of this legislation could cost a newly incorporated community council area up to \$10,000 for those modifications; this aggregate impact is unknown. To the extent that unincorporated islands remain in a county of the first class on July 1, 2027, enactment of this legislation could result in automatic annexation that likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

## Individuals & Businesses

Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct expenditures from tax or fee changes for Utah residents and businesses.

# **Regulatory Impact**

Enactment of this legislation likely will not change the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.
