

1.0 Department of Health-Nurse Education Financial Assistance Program

Summary

The Nurse Education Financial Assistance Program was established in 1992 to provide incentives to nursing students or recent graduates to contract to work in designated nursing-shortage areas, in exchange for financial assistance with loan repayments or tuition assistance.

Purpose

The Community Health Nursing (CHN) program administers the Nurse Education Financial Assistance Act, as provided by the Legislature in 1992. The Nurse Education Financial Assistance Program (NEFAP) provides scholarships and loan repayment grants for nurses in exchange for their agreement to work in needed nursing specialty areas or nursing shortage areas. The funds for the Nurse Education Financial Assistance Program are appropriated as a separate line item, as provided in 26-9d-9.

During FY 1999, the Nurse Financial Assistance Committee received 24 scholarship and 20 loan repayment applications. Of these, 13 scholarship and 13 grant contracts were signed. The program obligated \$106,025 in scholarship funds and \$76,280 in grant funds. The program expended \$55,890 for scholarships and \$104,374 for grants. Program adminsitrative expenses were \$56,809, of which \$1,704 was expended for committee activities. During FY 1992, two contracts were cancelled, but no contracts were breached. Since the inception of the program (FY 1992), 58 scholarship contracts have been signed for a total of \$493,728 and 66 grant contracts have been signed for a total obligation of \$507,003.

Since the program's inception, 31 grant recipients have completed their contracts, providing a total of 66.5 years of obligated service. Of the total 31 recipients, 16 continue to practice in the same shortage area where they completed their obligation. The total years of retention following contract completion is almost 25 years. Fourteen scholarship recipients have completed their contracts providing a total of 28.5 years of obligated service. Thirteen of these 14 recipients continue practicing in the same service area. The total years of retention following contract completion for scholarship recipients is almost 12 years. The total number of years of service for both grant and scholarship awards is 244.5 years.
