Description:

SB 217 (2010 GS) Increases the 85% surcharge to 90%. Creates a general fund restricted account known as the Law Enforcement Services Account for a portion of the increased amounts to be used for law enforcement around halfway houses. Upon appropriation, CCJJ will distribute fund monies to law enforcement agencies that have applied for grants. Provides that the Division of Finance shall allocate the first \$30,000 collected to the General Fund, and the next 4.5% of the 90% surcharge collected to the new account. The remainder as prescribed in UCA 51-9-403 through 411.

SB 164 (2013 GS) Modifies the uses of the Law Enforcement Services Account to include parole violator centers. Provides that funds available in the Law Enforcement Services Account may be distributed to law enforcement agencies in areas with parole violator centers as well as halfway houses. Provides that funds in the Law Enforcement Services Account must be used for law enforcement purposes to reduce crime in areas with parole violator centers as well as halfway houses. (Fund 1408)

SB 265 (2014 GS) Provides that funds available in the Law Enforcement Services Account (#1408) may be distributed to law enforcement agencies based on the number of contracted halfway house beds and the number of parole violator center beds occupied within their jurisdiction.
