The inability to protect another's privacy or HIPPA Rights is paramount in this Bill. Employees, other Residents, and family members in our homes are all covered. The innocent use of these images on Facebook, YouTube, etc. causes huge liability exposure for our business and the franchisees who own the various BeeHive Homes locations. We are a privately owned and operated businesses, or a "small business owner."

If a family has concerns for their loved one's care or property and wish to place a recording device, we will work with them and have done so in the past. This way we can control where the images are sent and how they are used. The safety and welfare of all our residents, employee's, and family members is our number one concern and effort.

Please consider the possible HIPPA violations of other residents, employees, and family members this would have. Please consider the burden of liability exposure this Bill places on Private Small Business Owners.

We urge you to vote "NO" on House Bill 124 "Granny Cam" or "Secret" videotaping of family members in an Assisted Living Home.
