**Background:** The Governor's budget recommendations for FY2015 demonstrate a continued focus on education, better aligning public education, technical education and higher education with the resources needed to achieve the Governor's goal of 66% of all Utah adults acquiring a certificate or degree by 2020—an economic necessity.

UVU is an ideal location to roll out the budget because of the role it is playing in raising the bar in education and its contributions to economic development.

The Governor's budget recommendations are based on current consensus revenue projections, agreed upon by both the Governor's Office and the Legislative Fiscal Analyst's Office.
