

Part 5
Unlawful and Unprofessional Conduct

58-79-501 Unlawful conduct.

"Unlawful conduct" includes, in addition to the definition in Section 58-1-501, using the title "hunting guide" or "outfitter" or any other title or designation to indicate that the individual is a hunting guide or outfitter or acting as a hunting guide or outfitter, unless the individual has a current license as a hunting guide or outfitter under this chapter.

58-79-502 Unprofessional conduct.

"Unprofessional conduct" includes, in addition to the definition in Section 58-1-501, and as may be further defined by rule:

- (1) engaging in an activity that would place a licensee's client, prospective client, or third party's safety at risk, recognizing the inherent risks associated with hunting wildlife and the activity engaged in being above and beyond those inherent risks;
- (2) using false, deceptive, or misleading advertising related to providing services as a hunting guide or outfitter; and
- (3) misrepresenting services, outcomes, facilities, equipment, or fees to a client or prospective client.
