This act enacts uncodified material.

Section 1. Appropriation.

~~h~~ ~~[\$3,000,000]~~ ~~\$ [\$3,750,000 h]~~ ~~\$3,500,000~~ \$ to the State Board of Education for distribution to

public school teachers for classroom

supplies and materials.

(3) Each teacher shall receive up to \$150 and may spend the money for school supplies, materials, or field trips under rules adopted by the State Board of Education.

(4) As used in this section:

(a) "Public schools" and "school districts" include the Schools for the Deaf and the Blind

and Applied Technology Centers.

(b) "Teachers" mean permanent teacher positions filled by one teacher or two or more job-sharing teachers who are certificated personnel, paid on the teacher's salary schedule, and whose primary function is to provide instructional or a combination of instructional and counseling services to students in the public schools. They must be hired by the district for an entire contract period.

Section 2. Effective date.
