~~——— (1) There is appropriated for fiscal year 1998-99 from the General Fund to the Utah Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety \$300,000 to provide computer equipment, training, and the hardware and software, including servers, scanners, and all other related equipment.~~

~~——— (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that this appropriation, as part of ongoing upgrade of troopers' computer access, shall be applied to the highway patrol field troopers serving in Utah and Juab counties, due to the populations in need of increased service in these counties.] §~~
