AN ACT RELATING TO RECREATIONAL TRAILS; APPROPRIATING ~~§ [\$400,000]~~ **\$100,000** § FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 1998-99 TO THE CENTENNIAL NONMOTORIZED PATHS AND TRAIL CROSSINGS PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act enacts uncodified material.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

**Section 1. Appropriation.**

(1) There is appropriated ~~§ [\$400,000]~~ **\$100,000** § from the General Fund for fiscal year 1998-99 to the Centennial Nonmotorized Paths and Trail Crossings Program created under Section 63-11a-503.

~~§ [(2) It is the intent of the Legislature that this appropriation be ongoing.] §~~

**Section 2. Effective date.**

This act takes effect on July 1, 1998.
