16	(a) diphtheria;
17	(b) haemophilus influenza type b;
18	(c) hepatitis B;
19	(d) measles;
20	(e) mumps;
21	(f) pertussis;
22	(g) polio;
23	(h) rubella;
24	(i) tetanus;
25	(j) varicella; and
26	(k) any other immunization required by law for the child.
27	(2) (a) Immunization benefits under Subsection (1) may not be subject to a deductible.
