

**APPROPRIATION FOR OGDEN-WEBER**

AN ACT RELATING TO APPLIED TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION; PROVIDING A \$299,000 APPROPRIATION TO PURCHASE A TRACT OF LAND FOR EXPANSION OF THE OGDEN-WEBER APPLIED TECHNOLOGY CENTER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act enacts uncodified material.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

**Section 1. Appropriation.**

(1) There is appropriated from the Uniform School Fund for fiscal year 1998-99, \$299,000 to the State Board for Applied Technology Education to purchase a tract of land for expansion of facilities at the Ogden-Weber Applied Technology Center.

(2) It is anticipated that the land would be developed to house additional custom fit training facilities at the center to further strengthen the institution's school-to-careers initiative and help to ensure that graduating students are employable.

**Section 2. Effective date.**

This act takes effect on July 1, 1998.
