This act enacts uncodified material.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Appropriation.

(1) There is appropriated from the Uniform School Fund for fiscal year 1998-99, ~~h~~ ~~[\$25,000]~~

(2) There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 1998-99, \$75,000 to the

Utah Arts Council for the development of cooperative programming with the State Office of

Education.
