AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH; AMENDING UNDERAGED POSSESSION OF TOBACCO LAW TO INCLUDE A PROHIBITION ON THE ATTEMPT TO PURCHASE TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

AMENDS:

76-10-105, as last amended by Chapter 194, Laws of Utah 1989

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **76-10-105** is amended to read:

76-10-105. Buying or possessing cigars, cigarettes, or tobacco by minors -- Penalty -- Compliance officer authority -- Juvenile court jurisdiction.

- (1) Any person under the age of 19 years who buys <u>or attempts to buy</u>, accepts, or has in his possession any cigar, cigarette, or tobacco in any form is guilty of a class C misdemeanor, or may be subject to the jurisdiction of the juvenile court.
- (2) A compliance officer appointed by a board of education under Section 53A-3-402 may issue citations for violations of this section committed on school property. Cited violations shall be reported to the appropriate juvenile court.
