

**APPROPRIATION FOR ENGINEERING AND
PREENGINEERING PROGRAM**

1998 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; PROVIDING A \$720,000
APPROPRIATION TO STRENGTHEN THE STATEWIDE INTEGRATION OF
ENGINEERING AND PREENGINEERING PROGRAMS AT THE STATE'S NINE
INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act enacts uncodified material.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Appropriation.

(1) There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 1998-99, \$720,000 to the State Board of Regents to strengthen the statewide integration of engineering and preengineering education programs at the state's nine institutions of higher education.

(2) \$320,000 of the appropriation is for base-budget funding of the programs and \$400,000 of the appropriation is one-time funding to be distributed to the institutions on that basis.

(3) The board shall distribute:

(a) \$89,600 for base-budget funding and \$112,000 in one-time moneys to the University of Utah;

(b) \$60,800 for base-budget funding and \$76,000 in one-time moneys to Utah State University;

(c) \$41,600 for base-budget funding and \$52,000 in one-time moneys to Weber State University;

(d) \$32,000 for base-budget funding and \$40,000 in one-time moneys to Salt Lake Community College;

(e) \$32,000 for base-budget funding and \$40,000 in one-time moneys to Utah Valley State College;

(f) \$16,000 for base-budget funding and \$20,000 in one-time moneys to the College of

Eastern Utah;

(g) \$16,000 for base-budget funding and \$20,000 in one-time moneys to Dixie College;

(h) \$16,000 for base-budget funding and \$20,000 in one-time moneys to Snow College; and

(i) \$16,000 for base-budget funding and \$20,000 in one-time moneys to Southern Utah

University.

Section 2. **Effective date.**

This act takes effect on July 1, 1998.
