AN ACT RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS; APPROPRIATING \$30,000,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 1998-99 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR MATCHING FUNDS FOR HIGHWAYS HIGHLY IMPACTED BY I-15 CONSTRUCTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act enacts uncodified material.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Appropriation.

(1) There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 1998-99, \$30,000,000 to the Department of Transportation.

(2) (a) It is the intent of the Legislature that this appropriation shall be used, as prioritized by the Transportation Commission, to fund improvements to state and local highways, except Interstate 15, that are highly impacted by the reconstruction of Interstate 15 in Salt Lake County.

(b) The Department of Transportation, counties, and municipalities may apply to the Transportation Commission for monies appropriated under this section for specific projects to mitigate the effects of the reconstruction of Interstate 15 in Salt Lake County.

(c) Each recipient of monies appropriated under this section shall provide matching funds from any available public or private sources. The matching funds shall be at least equal to the funds received from the Transportation Commission under this section.

(3) The money appropriated under Subsection (1) is nonlapsing.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act takes effect on July 1, 1998.
