1	(3) (a) There is created a restricted account within the General Fund entitled the "Trust
2	Fund for People with Disabilities."
3	(b) The Division of Finance shall deposit the following revenues into the fund:
4	(i) revenue from the sale, lease, except any lease existing on May 1, 1995, or other
5	disposition of real property associated with the developmental center;
6	(ii) revenue from the sale, lease, or other disposition of water rights associated with the
7	developmental center; and
8	(iii) revenue from voluntary contributions made to the fund.
9	(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 65A-4-1, any sale or disposition of real
10	property or water rights associated with the developmental center shall be conducted as [follows:]
11	provided in this Subsection (3)(c).
12	(i) [the] <u>The</u> division shall secure the approval of the governor through the director of the
13	Division of Facilities Construction and Management before making the sale or other disposition
14	of land or water rights[; and].
15	(ii) [the] The Division of Facilities Construction and Management shall sell or otherwise
16	dispose of the land or water rights as directed by the governor.

18	sales agreement with Utah Valley State College that:
