

1 (h) a comparison of contributory versus noncontributory retirement system contribution
2 rates;
3 (i) exemptions and exclusions from the system; and
4 (k) any other issues agreed upon by the board relating to unifying Chapters, 2, 3, 4, 4a, 5,
5 and 7 of Title 49, Utah State Retirement Act.

6 Section 2. **Report.**

7 The board shall prepare and present a written report of its findings to the Legislative
8 Retirement Committee on or before November 30, 1998, in anticipation of presenting the study
9 findings to the 1999 Legislature and for implementation by July 1, 1999.

10 Section 3. **Staffing.**

11 The Retirement Office shall provide staffing, including legal and actuarial services required
12 for the study.

13 Section 4. **Effective date.**

14 If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this act takes effect
15 upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah
16 Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto, the
17 date of veto override.
