10	This act enacts uncodified material.
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
12	Section 1. Intent.
13	The Legislature finds that the value of property throughout the state is enhanced by
14	appropriate land-use planning by the counties and other local governments and that the quality of
15	land-use planning improves with training and education. It is the intent of the Legislature in
16	appropriating these funds to help meet the statewide need for training and education of county,
17	local, and state officials involved in land-use planning activities to improve the quality of land-use
18	planning.
19	Section 2. Appropriation.
20	(1) (a) Except as provided in H.B. 4, Appropriations Coordination Act, there is
21	appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 1999-2000, \$250,000 to the Office of Planning
22	and Budget.
23	(b) The Office of Planning and Budget shall:
24	(i) distribute up to \$10,000 of the appropriated funds to Southern Utah University for use
25	by its Utah Center for Rural Life to conduct workshops on preparation of land-use plans, including
26	protection of private property rights and other rights attached to property;
27	(ii) determine, in conjunction with the Utah Association of Counties, the counties and

28	other local governments most qualified to receive the remainder of the appropriated funds to assist
29	in developing and implementing land-use plans, based on criteria established by the Office of
30	Planning and Budget;
31	(iii) consider the recommendations of the Governor's Rural Partnership Board in
32	determining the counties and other local governments most qualified to receive funds under
33	Subsection (1)(b)(ii);
34	(iv) receive the recommendation of the Governor's Local Government Comprehensive
35	Planning Project Steering Committee in establishing the criteria that are the basis of the
36	determination of the counties and other local governments most qualified to receive funds under
37	Subsection (1)(b)(ii); and
38	(v) distribute the remaining funds to counties and other local governments that:
39	(A) meet the criteria established by the Office of Planning and Budget;
40	(B) match the amount distributed by the Office of Planning and Budget in funds or in kind;
41	(C) agree to encourage county, local, and state officials involved with land-use planning
42	to attend the workshops; and
43	(D) agree to review and, if necessary, revise the comprehensive general plan at least
44	annually.
45	(c) In planning and presenting the workshops provided under Subsection (1)(b)(i),
46	Southern Utah University, through its Utah Center for Rural Life, may involve county and other
47	local government officials who are preparing or have completed a land-use plan.
