AN ACT RELATING TO THE UTAH NATURAL RESOURCES ACT; PROVIDING THAT FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES A VOLUNTEER IS CONSIDERED AN EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE.

This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

AMENDS:

**63-34-11**, as enacted by Chapter 186, Laws of Utah 1981

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **63-34-11** is amended to read:

**63-34-11. Volunteers as state employees.**

A volunteer is considered an employee of the state for the purposes [of:] stated in Section 67-20-3.

~~[(1) workmen's compensation benefits for any injury sustained by him while engaged in the performance of any service under the control and direction of the supervising agency;]~~

~~[(2) operation of state vehicles or equipment when he is properly licensed for that operation; and]~~

~~[(3) liability protection and indemnification normally afforded salaried employees.]~~
