13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
14	Section 1. Section 31A-22-610.1 is amended to read:
15	31A-22-610.1. Adoption indemnity benefit.
16	(1) (a) If an insured has coverage for maternity benefits $\$$ ON THE DATE OF AN ADOPTIVE
16a	PLACEMENT ş , the <u>insured's</u> policy shall provide
17	an <u>adoption</u> indemnity benefit payable to the insured, if [the] <u>a</u> child is placed for adoption with
18	the insured within [30] <u>90</u> days of the child's birth.
19	(b) An insurer that has paid the <u>adoption indemnity</u> benefit under Subsection (1)(a) may
20	seek reimbursement of the benefit if:
21	(i) the postplacement evaluation disapproves the adoption placement; and
22	(ii) a court rules the adoption may not be finalized because of an act or omission of an
23	adoptive parent or parents that affects the child's health or safety.
24	(c) The commissioner shall:
25	(i) establish, by rule, the amount of the adoption indemnity benefit provided under
26	Subsection (1) at a minimum of \$2,500; and
27	(ii) review the amount of the adoption indemnity benefit every two years to make any

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28	necessary and reasonable adjustments, taking into account the average insurance cost of an
29	uncomplicated birth.
30	(d) Each insurer shall pay its pro rata share of the adoption indemnity benefit if each
31	adoptive parent:
32	(i) has coverage for maternity benefits with a different insurer; and
33	(ii) makes a claim for the adoption indemnity benefit provided in Subsection (1)(a).
34	(2) If a policy offers optional maternity benefits, it shall also offer coverage for adoption
35	indemnity benefits if:
36	(a) [the] <u>a</u> child is placed for adoption with the insured within [$\frac{30}{90}$ days of the child's
37	birth; and
38	(b) the adoption is finalized within one year of the child's birth.
