This act enacts uncodified material.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Appropriation.**

For fiscal year 2000-01 only, there is appropriated from the § [~~General Fund~~] OLYMPIC SPECIAL REVENUE FUND § :

§ [~~(1)~~] § \$700,000 to the Division of Parks and Recreation to build a day lodge at Soldier Hollow in Wasatch Mountain State Park § [~~;~~ and] .

~~[(2) up to \$260,000 to the Heber Valley Historic Railroad Authority created under Title 9, Chapter 3, Part 3, Heber Valley Historic Railroad Authority, to be used to build a depot for the Heber Valley Historic Railroad. The appropriation in this Subsection (2) is contingent on matching funds from Wasatch County or any city or local municipality within that county.] §~~

Section 2. **Effective date.**

This act takes effect on July 1, 2000.
