AN ACT RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS; PROVIDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SUPPORT OF STATE GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2000 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2001, AND FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1999 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2000 FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF CERTAIN STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES OF STATE GOVERNMENT AND PROVIDING APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE BILLS PASSED IN THE 2000 GENERAL SESSION WITH FISCAL IMPACT; APPROVING CERTAIN FEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES AS IN THIS ACT PROVIDED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Utah:

Section 1. Under the terms and conditions of Section 63-38-3, the following sums of money are appropriated out of money not otherwise appropriated from the funds or fund account indicated for the use and support of certain State departments and agencies for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001. This is in addition to amounts appropriated in Senate Bill 1, 2000 General Session.

	It is further the Legislature's intent that municipalities and counties allow for consideration of exception to the dispersal requirements on a case-by- case basis. It is the sense of the legislature that providers are responsible to demonstrate to the municipality or county why their facility should be granted this exemption.	
	The Legislature acknowledges that state and federal fair housing law exempts from its coverage anyone who, despite services and	

accommodations, poses a direct threat to the health or safety of other individuals or whose tenancy would result in substantial physical damage to the property of others.

It is the intent of the Legislature that monies appropriated to the Division of Aging and Adult Services in Senate Bill 1 Annual Appropriations Act, 2000 General Session, be made nonlapsing.

It is further the intent of the Legislature that these nonlapsing monies be used for transportation of meals and for senior transportation.
