APPROPRIATION FOR WINNERS OF HISTORY CONTESTS

2000 GENERAL SESSION STATE OF UTAH

AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; PROVIDING A \$7,500 APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO HELP PAY THE EXPENSES OF STUDENTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN AND WIN HISTORY CONTESTS HELD AT THE STATE LEVEL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act enacts uncodified material.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Appropriation.**

- (1) For fiscal year 2000-01 only, there is appropriated from the Uniform School Fund to the State Board of Education \$7,500 to help pay for up to 50% of the expenses for travel and lodging incurred by students who:
 - (a) participate in; and
 - (b) win history contests or competitions held at the state level.
- (2) In accordance with Title 63, Chapter 46a, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, the State Board of Education may make rules regarding:
 - (a) what qualifies as a legitimate expense under Subsection (1); and
- (b) the procedures students must follow to receive financial assistance under Subsection (1).

Section 2. Effective date.

This act takes effect on July 1, 2000.
