Section 1. **HR-24.05** is amended to read:

HR-24.05. Standing Committees.

(1) The Speaker shall appoint the following standing committees:

~~[(8)]~~ (h) Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment;

~~[(9)]~~ (i) Political Subdivisions;

~~[(10)]~~ (j) Public Utilities and Technology;

~~[(11)] Retirement;~~

~~[(12)]~~ (k) Revenue and Taxation;

~~[(13)]~~ (l) Transportation; and

~~[(14)]~~ (m) Workforce Services.

(2) The Legislative Quasi-Governmental Entities Committee created in Section 63-95-201 appointed from the members of the House of Representatives constitute a standing committee.

Section 2. **Effective date.**

This resolution takes effect upon approval by a constitutional majority vote of all members of the House of Representatives.
