27 [(10)] (j) Public Utilities and Technology;

28 [~~(11)~~ Retirement;]
29 [~~(12)~~] (k) Revenue and Taxation;
30 [~~(13)~~] (l) Transportation; and
31 [~~(14)~~] (m) Workforce Services.
32 (2) The Legislative Quasi-Governmental Entities Committee created in Section 63-95-201
33 appointed from the members of the House of Representatives constitute a standing committee.
34 Section 2. **Effective date.**
35 This resolution takes effect upon approval by a constitutional majority vote of all members
