AN ACT RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSING;  
AMENDING THE EXEMPTIONS TO LICENSURE AS A COSMETOLOGIST/BARBER; AND  
MAKING TECHNICAL CHANGES.

This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

AMENDS:

**58-11a-304**, as enacted by Chapter 96, Laws of Utah 1996

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **58-11a-304** is amended to read:

**58-11a-304. Exemptions from licensure.**

In addition to the exemptions from licensure in Section 58-1-307, the following persons may engage in the practice of cosmetology/barbering without being licensed under this chapter:

(1) persons licensed under the laws of this state to engage in the practice of medicine, surgery, osteopathy, or chiropractic when engaged in the practice of the profession for which they are licensed;

(2) commissioned physicians and surgeons serving in the armed forces of the United States or another federal agency;

(3) registered nurses, undertakers, and morticians licensed under the laws of this state when engaged in the practice of the profession for which they are licensed;

(4) persons who visit the state to engage in instructional seminars or competitions of a limited duration;

(5) persons who engage in the practice of cosmetology/barbering without compensation;

(6) persons instructing adult education classes and other educational programs directed toward persons who are not licensed in cosmetology/barbering and that are not intended to train persons to become licensed to engage in cosmetology/barbering, provided:

(a) each instructor is licensed as a cosmetologist/barber; and

(b) attendees receive no credit toward the educational requirement for licensure; ~~and~~

(7) persons instructing in workshops, seminars, training meetings, and other educational programs whose purpose is to provide continuing professional development to licensed cosmetologist/barbers or electrologists[-]; and

(8) persons currently enrolled in a licensed cosmetology/barber school may participate in an on the job training internship under the direct supervision of a licensed cosmetologist/barber upon completion of a basic program under the standards established by rule by the division in collaboration with the board.
