A RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE REVISING SENATE RULES; CHANGING THE RETIREMENT STANDING COMMITTEE TO THE QUASI-GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES STANDING COMMITTEE; MAKING TECHNICAL CHANGES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This resolution affects legislative rules as follows:

AMENDS:

SR-24.05

Be it resolved by the Senate of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **SR-24.05** is amended to read:

SR-24.05. Standing Committees.

(1) The President shall appoint the following standing committees:

~~[(1)]~~ (a) Business, Labor, and Economic Development;

~~[(3)]~~ (c) Energy, Natural Resources, and Agriculture;

~~[(4)]~~ (d) Health and Environment;

~~[(5)]~~ (e) Human Services;

~~[(6)]~~ (f) Judiciary;

~~[(7)] Retirement;~~

~~[(8)]~~ (g) Revenue and Taxation;

~~[(9)]~~ (h) Senate Rules;

~~[(10)]~~ (i) State and Local Affairs; and

~~[(11)]~~ (j) Transportation and Public Safety.

(2) The members of the Legislative Quasi-Governmental Entities Committee created in Section 63-95-201 appointed from the Senate constitute a standing committee.

Section 2. **Effective date.**

This resolution takes effect upon approval by a constitutional majority vote of all members of the Senate.
