- (f) judgments of not guilty by reason of insanity for a violation of:
- (i) a felony offense;
- (ii) Title 76, Chapter 5, Offenses Against the Person; or
- (iii) Title 76, Chapter 10, Part 5, Weapons;
- (g) judgments of guilty and mentally ill;
- (h) finding of mental incompetence to stand trial for a violation of:
- (i) a felony offense;
- (ii) Title 76, Chapter 5, Offenses Against the Person; or
- (iii) Title 76, Chapter 10, Part 5, Weapons; or
- (i) probations granted; and"
