This act requires the Lieutenant Governor's Elections Office to study and report possible methods for allowing persons with disabilities to vote a secret ballot.

This act enacts uncodified material.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Voting by persons with disabilities study.**

(1) The Lieutenant Governor's State Elections Office, in consultation with county clerks,

shall study possible ways to allow persons with disabilities to vote by secret ballot in accordance with Section 20A-3-102.

(2) The State Elections Office shall report the findings of its study and make

recommendations to the Government Operations Interim Committee by October 1, 2001.
