18	[(1)] (2) In addition to the purposes set out in Subsections 67-20-3(2) and (3), a volunteer
19	firefighter[, as defined in Section 49-5-103,] is considered an agency employee for the purpose of
20	receiving workers' compensation benefits under Title [35A] 34A, Chapter [3] 2, Workers'
21	Compensation Act, and Chapter [3a] 3, Utah Occupational Disease Act.
22	[(2) These] (3) The workers' compensation benefits as described in Subsection (2) are the

25	(4) To compute the workers' compensation benefits for a volunteer firefighter, the weekly

- 26 <u>compensation rate of the volunteer firefighter</u> shall be computed [as indicated in Section 49-5-802]
- by multiplying the state's average weekly wage by 108%.
