16	(1) There is established an Educational Enrichment Program for Hearing and Visually
17	Impaired Students.
18	(2) The purpose of the program is to provide opportunities that will, in a family friendly
19	environment, enhance the educational services required for hearing impaired, visually impaired,
20	or dual sensory impaired students.
21	(3) The Institutional Council for the Schools for the Deaf and the Blind shall design and
22	implement the program, subject to approval by the State Board of Education.
23	(4) The program shall be funded from the interest and dividends derived from the
24	permanent fund created for the Schools for the Deaf and the Blind pursuant to Section 12 of the
25	Utah Enabling Act and distributed by the director of the School and Institutional Trust Lands
26	Administration under Section 53C-3-103 in accordance with Title 51, Chapter 7, State Money
27	Management Act.
