

Senator Terry R. Spencer proposes to substitute the following bill:

**HIGH-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE**

**APPROPRIATION**

2001 GENERAL SESSION

STATE OF UTAH

**Sponsor: Terry R. Spencer**

This act appropriates, over two fiscal years, \$ [~~\$1,600,000~~] \$1,300,000 <sup>h</sup> from the General Fund to the

Department of Environmental Quality to be used to oppose the off site storage of high-level or greater than class C nuclear waste within the exterior boundaries of the state. This act

appropriates \$ [~~\$600,000~~] \$300,000 <sup>h</sup> as a one-time appropriation for fiscal year 2000-01, and the effective

date for this appropriation is April 30, 2001. This act also appropriates <sup>h</sup> [~~\$1,000,000~~

\$800,000 <sup>h</sup> as an

ongoing appropriation for fiscal year 2001-02, and the effective date for this appropriation is July 1, 2001. Both appropriations are nonlapsing.

This act enacts uncodified material.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. **Appropriation for fiscal year 2000-01.**

(1) For fiscal year 2000-01 only, there is appropriated \$ [~~\$600,000~~] \$300,000 <sup>h</sup> from the General Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality.

(2) It is the intent of the Legislature that this appropriation be used by the department, acting in consultation with the office of the governor, to oppose and prevent <sup>h</sup> , INCLUDING BY

**MEANS OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:**

**(a) <sup>h</sup> the off site storage**
