1. Page 40, Line 1211:

After line 1211 insert:

"Section 32. **Appropriation.** 

(1) Under the terms and conditions of Section 63-38-3, the following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002. This is in addition to amounts appropriated by House Bill 1, 2001 General Session and Senate Bill 3, 2001 General Session. Appropriations referenced below as provided in House Bill 1, 2001 General Session and Senate Bill 3, 2001 General Session remain in effect until September 1, 2001, and any obligations made from the appropriations referenced below in House Bill 1, 2001 General Session and Senate Bill 3, 2001 General Session between July 1, 2001 and September 1, 2001 will reduce the amounts appropriated below. In cases where a portion of the following sums has been obligated between July 1, 2001 and September 1, 2001, the unobligated balance of each of the debited line items shall supercede the amounts indicated below in both the debited and corresponding credited items.
