5 **This act modifies the Motor Vehicle Code by \hat{h} [amending] repealing \hat{h} an exception to seat belt**
5a **laws.**

6 This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

7 AMENDS:

8 **41-6-183**, as last amended by Chapter 153, Laws of Utah 2000

9 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

10 Section 1. Section **41-6-183** is amended to read:

11 **41-6-183. Exceptions.**

12 \hat{h} [(†)] \hat{h} This article does not apply to a driver or passenger of:

13 \hat{h} [(*)] (1) \hat{h} a motor vehicle manufactured before July 1, 1966;

14 \hat{h} [(†)] (2) \hat{h} a motor vehicle in which the driver or passengers possess a written verification
14a from

15 a licensed physician that the driver or passenger is unable to wear a safety belt for physical or
16 medical reasons; or

17 \hat{h} [(*)] (3) \hat{h} a motor vehicle or seating position which is not required to be equipped with a
17a safety

18 belt system under federal law.

19 \hat{h} [(2)] ~~This article does not apply to a passenger who is an immediate family member, as~~
20 ~~defined in Section 76-5-106.5, of the driver if all seating positions are occupied by other~~
21 ~~passengers.] \hat{h}~~
