6 **This act modifies the Criminal Code by amending the offense of giving false information to**
7 **a peace officer to include the specific offense of giving the name or identification of another**
8 **person.**

9 This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

10 AMENDS:

11 **76-8-507**, as last amended by Chapter 97, Laws of Utah 1983

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

13 Section 1. Section **76-8-507** is amended to read:

14 **76-8-507. False personal information to peace officer.**

15 (1) A person commits a class C misdemeanor if, with intent of misleading a peace officer
16 as to ~~[his]~~ the person's identity, birth date, or place of residence, ~~[he]~~ the person knowingly gives
17 a false name, birth date, or address to a peace officer in the lawful discharge of ~~[his]~~ the peace
