6	This act creates the Utah Lake Authority Legislative Task Force. The act provides for
7	membership of the task force and compensation of members. The act outlines the
8	responsibilities and duties of the task force. The act provides for reports to various
9	legislative committees. The act appropriates \$29,500 from the General Fund for fiscal year
10	2001-02. The act provides for staffing of the task force. The act is repealed November 30,
11	2002.
12	This act enacts uncodified material.
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
14	Section 1. Utah Lake Authority Legislative Task Force Creation Membership
15	Interim rules followed Compensation Staff.
16	(1) There is created the Utah Lake Authority Legislative Task Force consisting of the
17	following 12 members:
18	(a) five members of the Senate appointed by the president of the Senate, no more than
19	three of whom may be from the same political party; and
20	(b) seven members of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker of the House
21	of Representatives, no more than four of whom may be from the same political party.
22	(2) (a) The president of the Senate shall designate a member of the Senate appointed under
23	Subsection (1)(a) as a cochair of the committee.
24	(b) The speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate a member of the House
25	of Representatives appointed under Subsection (1)(b) as a cochair of the committee.
26	(3) In conducting its business, the committee shall comply with the rules of legislative
7	interim committees

28	(4) Salaries and expenses of the members of the committee shall be paid in accordance
29	with Section 36-2-2 and Legislative Joint Rule 15.03.
30	(5) The Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel shall provide staff support to
31	the committee.
32	Section 2. Duties Interim report.
33	(1) The committee shall review and make recommendations on the following issues:
34	(a) the feasibility of creating a lake authority for the management and development of Utah
35	Lake;
36	(b) possible funding source for a Utah Lake Authority other than general tax revenues,
37	including fees on property that would be enhanced by the development of the lake and fees from
38	additional water capacity in the lake;
39	(c) the feasibility and effects of dredging portions of the lake and creating islands in the
40	<u>lake;</u>
41	(d) the construction of a causeway across the lake and potential funding sources for the
42	causeway, including the collection of tolls;
43	(e) the potential economic development benefits of improvements to the lake; and
44	(f) the potential for increased water storage and conservation in the lake.
45	(2) A final report, including any proposed legislation shall be presented before November
46	30, 2002, to the:
47	(a) Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee;
48	(b) Revenue and Taxation Interim Committee;
49	(c) Workforce Services and Economic Development Interim Committee; and
50	(d) Legislative Management Committee.
51	Section 3. Appropriation.
52	There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 2001-02, a one-time
53	appropriation of:
54	(1) \$6,000 to the Senate to pay for the compensation and expenses of senators on the
55	committee;
56	(2) \$8,500 to the House of Representatives to pay for the compensation and expenses of
57	representatives on the committee; and
58	(3) \$15,000 to the Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel to pay for staffing
